RE-T6702 is a double-sided, repulpable adhesive tape that's used for flying splices. The tape has a very high wet grab. The repulpable tape has a silicone coated glassine paper liner and is coated with a water soluble, acrylic adhesive. Available in light green, this tape is used for high-speed automatic splicing on newsprint offset printing, web printing, flexographic printing, and rotogravure printing.
